## Missionary's Message

The Christmas season has ended, and a new year is upon us. For several months now, I have been thinking about the idea of peace. Specifically, peace in the church. At Christmas, we can't escape the reality that Jesus came to bring peace. Isaiah prophesied that the child born for us would be named Prince of Peace (see Isaiah 9:6-7). When the birth of Christ was announced to the shepherds, the angel of the Lord and the heavenly host praised God by saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and peace on earth to people he favors!" (see Luke 2:13-14). In Colossians 1:19-20, Paul writes, "For God was pleased to have all his fullness dwell in him, and through him to reconcile everything to himself, whether things on earth or things in heaven, by **making peace** through his blood shed on the cross." Jesus is the ultimate peacemaker.

It should naturally follow that if Jesus came to establish peace between God and people, then there should be peace between people who have experienced the peace of Christ. The Scriptures exhort us to be a people of peace, love, and unity.

**Romans 12:10, 18:** "Love one another deeply as brothers and sisters. Outdo one another in showing honor...If possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."

**Romans 14:19:** "So then, let us pursue what promotes peace and what builds up one another."

**Ephesians 4:3:** "...making every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace." (see also Ephesians 4:1-6)

**Hebrews 12:14:** "Pursue peace with everyone, and holiness – without it no one will see the Lord."

Admittedly, peace is not something that comes easily or is maintained without effort. That's why we see words like "pursue" and "make every effort" in the verses listed above. Peacemaking is active, not passive. It takes intentionality and work. It must be a culture that is cultivated within the church.

In an effort to assist churches with fostering a culture of peace, I am developing a biblical peacemaking workshop. The workshop will focus on the causes of conflict in the church. We will also discover our natural responses to conflict along with understanding the steps to take to resolve conflict in a biblical, God-glorifying manner. My goal is to be ready to share the workshop at the end of January. The workshop can be conducted over a series of 2-3 Sunday or Wednesday nights or an extended period on a Saturday morning. If you would like for your church to participate in this workshop, let me know and we'll develop a format that works best for you. I pray that your 2018 will be filled with the peace of Christ!

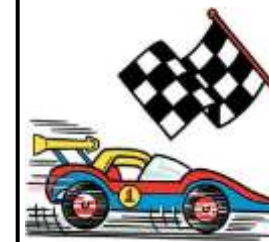
