Missionary's Message

Are you striving to build genuine, Christ-centered community in your local church? Are you striving for unity under the Headship of Jesus Christ? Are you praying for your brothers and sisters in Christ? Pastors, are you praying for the flock God has given you to shepherd? Church members, are you praying for your pastor to faithfully preach the Word of God, make disciples, and lead your church in a way that brings glory to God?

In his book, *Life Together*, Dietrich Bonhoeffer addresses the topic of Christ-centered community. Let his words soak deep into your heart and mind:

The more genuine and the deeper our community becomes, the more will everything else between us recede, the more clearly and purely will Jesus Christ and his work become the one and only thing that is vital between us. We have one another only through Christ, but through Christ we do have one another, wholly, and for eternity. (p. 26)

That dismisses once and for all every clamorous desire for something more. One who wants more than what Christ has established does not want Christian brotherhood. He is looking for some extraordinary social experience which he has not found elsewhere; he is bringing muddled and impure desires into Christian brotherhood. (p. 26)

If we do not give thanks daily for the Christian fellowship in which we have been placed, even where there is no great experience, no discoverable riches, but much weakness, small faith, and difficulty; if on the contrary, we only keep complaining to God that everything is so paltry and petty, so far from what we expected, then we hinder God from letting our fellowship grow according to the measure and riches which are there for us all in Jesus Christ. (p. 29)
