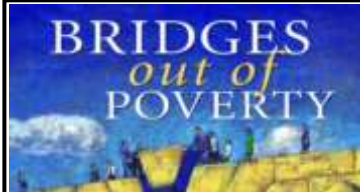

Missionary's Message

What is the church's greatest witness to the world? Is it our ministry and mission efforts? Is it our worship style? Is it our dynamic programs and grand events? Is it our talented musicians? Is it our gifted preachers and teachers? Is it our commitment to teaching deep theological truths? What is it? Consider what Jesus prayed in John 17:20-23:

I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. The glory that you have given me I have given to them that they may be one even as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

Did you see that? Jesus prayed for oneness (unity) among his believers. He said unity is our greatest witness to the world.

Our unity is a gospel issue. The only way we can be one with each other is for each of us to be in Christ. The only way to be in Christ is to repent and believe the gospel. When we do this, Christ transforms us and enables us to love one another and live in unity with one another for the purpose of seeing more people repent and believe the gospel.

We don't have to look far to see that the world is filled with strife, division, and hatred. Sadly, the church isn't much different. Instead of being a community that is rooted in biblical unity and Christ-honoring love, the church often reflects the attitudes and ways of the world. This kills our witness because we show ourselves to be no different than the world. Jesus prayed that the world would see something different in us and it would be so compelling that the world would know that the Father had sent him.

Is your church struggling to effectively reach people with the gospel and make disciples? It may not be an issue with programs (or lack thereof), worship styles, etc. The real issue your church may need to address is your lack of unity. True unity will only come about through earnest prayer, humility, repentance before God, and reconciliation with one another. It will take work, but it will be worth it because it will be for the sake of the gospel.
