God has a purpose for every church. There is much that He wants to do through every church. However, it has been our experience that God gives each church and its leaders "crossroads moments" in their history where they must make decisions based on faith if they are to continue to be used to fulfill the purposes God has in mind for them. It has also been our experience that the current health of any church is a summation of the decisions made over many years.

There are often times when churches must make changes, sometimes quite dramatic ones, but a church with Christ as its Head need never be discouraged or struggle. Recently, in the book "Flickering Lamps: Christ and His Church", my father and I were given the opportunity to use his journey as pastor of Faith Baptist Church in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan as an example of what God can do to revive any church. We believe God can, and will, transform any church, taking us to new levels of effectiveness in ministry and mission, if His people will surrender themselves fully to Him.

Whether your church is experiencing positive spiritual health or finds itself plateaued or struggling, it is vitally important to be centered on and oriented to the Headship of Christ. It is my prayer that you will set aside time to attend the entire gathering in May, determined to park your heart before God, allowing Him to speak to you in fresh and transforming ways.
