## Missionary's Message

For many churches, summer is a wonderful time to be on mission. I follow many SRBA churches on social media and it is awesome to see how they are glorifying God by sharing the love of Christ in local, national, and international settings.

Recently, I read a great article in the Summer 2018 issue of *Tarheel Talk*, a publication from the NC WMU, that gives summer mission/service project ideas for families. Here are a few of the ideas from the list:

**Host a Book Drive:** Collect gently used books, CDs and DVDs and donate them to schools, libraries, homeless shelters, and nursing homes.

**Be a Neighbor:** Challenge each child to help three neighbors with small things around their house. Older kids can help by weeding, mowing, painting, housesitting, or pet-sitting. Preschoolers can deliver flowers or handmade cards.

**Host a Toy Drive:** Everybody does it at Christmas but kids need toys year-round. Choose a time during the middle of the year and encourage everyone to drop off toys to be donated.

**Visit a Nursing Home:** The initial visit for this one takes the longest. First, meet with the Activities Director for a few minutes, fill-out any needed paperwork and set a date for your family to visit. Some suggested activities include singing, bringing flowers, or just visiting with the residents.

**Volunteer to Read:** Offer to staff your library's reading hour with families from your church, or encourage kids to help younger readers at their schools.

**Say "Thanks" to First Responders:** Prepare baked goods and treats and deliver them to the local police and fire stations.

**Clean up:** Participate in cleaning up your local neighborhood, park or community center.
