Missionary's Message

We had a great time at the SRBA Annual Meeting that took place Monday, October 15 at First Baptist, Washington. I am thankful for First Baptist, Washington hosting the meeting even though they are also hosting dozens of disaster relief volunteers from Virginia.

At our meeting, we celebrated what God has done and is doing through SRBA churches that are networking together to fulfill the Great Commission. We also heard about several new and continuing initiatives that will take place in 2019. Our desire is to continue The Jerusalem Project next year. The Jerusalem Project is basically a mission trip in our association. For the past two years, we have partnered with churches in a specific location to show and share the love of Christ. So far, The Jerusalem Project has taken place in south Greenville and Tarboro. We also want to continue to build and strengthen partnership opportunities between SRBA churches and church planters in Chicago. So far, we have around four churches that have partnered with churches and planters in Chicago. I am looking at the possibility of taking another vision tour with SRBA pastors along with coordinating a mission trip to Chicago.

Two new initiatives include BLESS Every Home and Multi-housing ministry. BLESS Every Home is a Pray, Care, Share, Disciple ministry that is sponsored by the Mapping Center for Evangelism and Church Growth. You will see more information about this opportunity in the middle page of the newsletter. I would love to see members of SRBA churches praying for thousands of their neighbors. At our annual meeting, I introduced Stephen Bradley as our new Impacting Lostness Intern. Stephen is currently starting a new church in Greenville. As our intern, Stephen will serve as an Apartment and Multi-housing Ministry Catalyst. He will work to equip and mobilize SRBA churches for multi-housing ministry. Our vision for this ministry is to see a reproducing gospel presence in apartments and multi-housing complexes throughout the SRBA. The mission is to encourage SRBA churches to EMBRACE apartment and multi-housing communities and EQUIP them to ENGAGE apartment and multi-housing communities with the gospel in order to make reproducing disciples. The strategy for doing this is called the PEOPLE Plan. You will be hearing more about this ministry and the PEOPLE Plan in the weeks to come. If your church is interested in reaching multi-housing complexes with the gospel, let us know. We would very much like to connect with you and share more

information about this ministry.

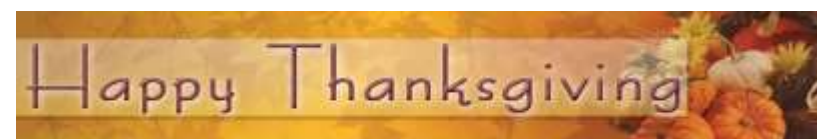
