Interim Associational Mission Strategist's Message

A golfing story was told by Ed Rowell, a former diplomat in the U.S. Foreign Service: A golfer's tee shot sailed far off course and landed on an ant hill. The golfer took a mighty swing and missed the ball, striking the ant hill instead. Thousands of ants were killed. The man took another swing, missed again, and killed more ants. One of the surviving ants yelled, "follow me." Another ant asked, "where are we going?" The first ant pointed to the golf ball and replied, "There. If we don't get on the ball, we're going to die!!!"

The golf story is a mirror of recent surveys. The devil has been Jusing his golf club to swing at Christendom in America. In 2019, for example, there were about 3,000 new church starts, but 4,500 churches closed. Today, less than half of all Americans identify themselves as practicing Christians. More than 20% of the population are atheists or have no religious preference. Seven of every 10 unchurched Americans say no Christian has ever shared the Gospel with them.

The devil has been busy, aptly described as a prowling lion looking for someone to devour (1 Peter 5:8-9). The lion's tactic is to separate one sheep at a time from the flock. We need to think of "flock" in the broadest sense, from local communities, to your church, and to churches in our Association. We all ascribe to the Great Commission of Matthew 28:19-20; and when you look at the verb "go", it is plural, as is "you." We are meant to go together, not as an individual or a single church. To that end, I encourage each pastor and church in the South Roanoke Baptist Association is to "get on the ball" during our transition to the calling of a new Associational Mission Strategist (AMS).

:A wonderful opportunity to get on the ball will occur at our Quarterly Gathering of Churches on Monday, July 17th at Riverview Baptist in Washington, NC. We will begin at 6:30 p.m. with a half-hour reception, where you can meet the 8 members of the AMS Search Team, representing 8 of our churches. Ask questions; get to know them. Each attendee will have the chance to provide input to the search process via a short survey to be completed at the meeting. Roy Smith, our guest speaker, will address value of having a transition to transformation. You will hear the testimony of each Team member, and we will conclude with the laying on of hands and praying over the Search Team.

I am urging members from every church to get on the ball and come to the Gathering on July 17th. What an encouragement it would be for the Search Team to see a large turnout!
